## PGMI GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Word Count: Limit word count to 250 words.

**Title:** It should be concise not exceeding 15 words and accurately reflect the content of research article.

**Author's Names:** Write name of Principal Investigator as 1<sup>st</sup> Author. Also write names of coauthors. Maximum number of authors should not be more than six.

Authors' Designation should also mentioned.

Name of Institution/department should be mentioned.

Address for Correspondence: Institutional address should be mentioned.

**Email address** of 1<sup>st</sup> Author/Principal Investigator should be provided.

## Abstract:

**Background/Introduction:** It should not be more than two sentences outlining the rationale and significance of the research study.

**Objective(s):** Provide specific, measurable, achievable, realistic and time-bound (SMART) objective(s).

**Methods:** Mention study design, place and duration of study, ethical approval, sample size & sampling technique, inclusion & exclusion criteria, interventions (if any), study variables, data collection procedure and statistical tests used for analysis.

**Results:** Show key findings as text, tables & illustrations. Mention only important observations and significant statistics.

**Conclusion:** A concluding statement aligned with the study objectives and results should be given.

**References:** Only 2 to 3 relevant references supporting the rationale/significance and/or methods of the study should mentioned. Use Vancouver style of referencing.
